*******New Paddle Rotations*******

New signs have been mounted at the courts listing some new guidelines for court rotation and court designations. Advanced play on courts 1 through 4, Intermediate play on courts 5 through 10, and Beginner play on courts 11 and 12. Paddle holders have been placed for a “two court” rotation. For example, if two paddles are up for play at courts 5 & 6, those two paddles will play on the next court that becomes available (whether it is court 5 or 6). These changes were made from suggestions by the Focus group that met last February.

The Board will monitor play throughout the summer to observe how the changes are progressing.
