



**SCPD - PICKLEBALL CLUB BOARD MEETING MINUTES  
November 3, 2025**

- I. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 3:00 pm by Rich Allison.
- II. **Meeting Location:** Lakeview Club House, Silverwood Room
- III. **Attendance:** Rich Allison, Bob Briedis, Sandy Berk, Rick Dowdle, Ron Golden, Tom Watson
- IV. **The Minutes** of October 6, 2025, were reviewed by the board. There was a motion to approve the minutes as written by Ms. Berk, a second by Mr. Briedis, and there was a unanimous vote to approve the board minutes as written.
- V. **The Treasurer's Report** was prepared and presented by Mr. Briedis. Mr. Briedis reported a checking account balance of \$21,071 as of November 3, 2025. There was a motion to approve the treasurer's report by Mr. Dowdle, and a second by Mr. Allison, and a unanimous vote was carried to approve the report written.
- VI. **Membership** was reported there were 246 paid members as November 3, 2025. When compared to last year at the same time, our membership is down by 45 members.
- VII. **Calendar** has been established and published for the season by Ms. Berk. The most recent potluck of October 28<sup>th</sup> was perhaps the most successful with 50+ people in attendance.
- VIII. **Demo Day** - Mr. Watson is taking the lead on the Pickleball Demo Day, which is set for January 24<sup>th</sup>. He indicated that he has four (4) paddle companies that will participate at this time. He is exploring several others companies to see if they are interested in participation.
- IX. **Toy Drive** – The Holiday toy drive will be in coordinated with a local realtor. This toy drive will include several other SCPD clubs. The holiday toys will be distributed to Twentynine Palms military base and several other local charities.
- X. **Pickleball Ladders** – Pickleball ladders groups (men's, women's, couples) are ready to start. Most flyers have gone out soliciting participation have gone out. Mr. Briedis has organized an excel worksheet for the tracking ladders participation and scores. Mr. Briedis has now instructed the leaders of each group on how to record scores and select teams.
- XI. **Tech Consult** – There continues to be strong interest in the current club website as s method of membership and event registration. This topic will continue to be explored by the board to find a viable solution to both the website and its future capabilities.
