

## PICKLEBALL CLUB BOARD MEETING September 4, 2023

- 1) Rich called the meeting to order at 3:11 p.m.
- 2) Meeting Minutes - Rich moved to approve the meeting minutes from the board meeting on August 11, 2023. Sandy Berk seconded. Passed.
- 3) Director of Communication position added. Vicki Harrison will fill the position as a member at large supporting the club and the board.
- 4) Taffy Golden in our June 2023 meeting volunteered to do membership for the club for 2024. She will be in charge of reporting the dues and keeping the membership roster up to date for the board and overseeing the club mailbox.
- 5) Court Designation. Courts 1-11 will be open courts for all player levels. Court 12 will be designated as a Beginner Court.
- 6) FRC may not participate in the purchase of the new paddle holders this year. Motion to move forward with replacing them with club funds only. All board members favored the new paddle holders to be purchased.
- 7) Screens on the courts have been repaired. Painting on court #2 postponed. Court paint costs \$180 for 5 gallons.
- 8) Court Rotation (4 players on and 4 players off) will be introduced at the General Meeting on October 26, 2023.
- 9) Introduction to Pickleball will be coordinated by Randi Allison. The club provided lessons Margo Perry will coordinate Beginner Lessons and Todd Rainey will coordinate Intermediate Lessons. 16 members in Beginner lessons, 16 members in Introductory lessons and 12 members in Intermediate lessons. Weekly signup/calendar for lessons will be provided.
- 10) Todd Rainey and Brian and Julie Sribney need to connect regarding Intermediate 102 lessons.
- 11) The court schedule for lessons, clinics and open play is currently being reconciled. Also, the paddle rotation system and rules and guidelines are being drafted.
- 12) Motion to approve purchase of pickleballs for club provided lessons has been approved (100 balls).

- 13) Ball machine time/dates will be posted. Court #2 will be reserved for ball machine usage.
- 14) Ladders start in November. Bob Briedis will coordinate Men's ladders with Frank Parks. Nancy Caneday will coordinate Women's Ladders. Mixed Doubles will start in November and Jean Mylan will coordinate.
- 15) Clinics, classes and club functions volunteers to meet and report to board.
- 16) November 2, 2023, Expo scheduled from 10 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. We will have our own table that the tennis club can share with us. Volunteers can sign up for future pickleball events during Expo.
- 17) Demo Day Coordinator needed. Paddle manufacturer and apparel outfitters will be onsite.
- 18) October 21, 2023 Mixer, Director of Communication will put out notice.
- 19) The club has 3 approved Pro's. Lisa Naumu, Roger Schaljo and Debbie Reardon these Pros can charge for lessons. Volunteers cannot charge if instructing.
- 20) Friday Night Lights is scheduled for once a month. For liability purposes there are a few dates we will have to pay the HOA maintenance folks overtime to put away the chairs and tables.
- 21) Casino Night at this time we are postponing and the club has opted to do a Dinner/Dance in lieu of which will be in January of 2024. We will look at a date in the early part of 2025 to have a casino night for our club.
- 22) October General Meeting, before the meeting we want to introduce Friday Night Lights, evening play and new paddle holders and rotation.
- 23) We will be putting up laminated signs to turn lights off on courts when leaving at night.
