New to Sun City Pickleball?

SUN CITY PICKLEBALL COURT PLAY AND ROTATION RULES

DROP-IN BY SKILL LEVEL 6:30AM TO 11AM EVERYDAY (UNLESS A CLUB ACTIVITY IS SCHEDULED)

- DURING THIS TIME HOMEOWNERS AND RENTERS CAN ENJOY A SPONTANEOUS FORMAT THAT ALLOWS INDIVIDUALS TO SHOW UP AND PLAY BUT WITH SKILL-LEVEL DIVISION.
- PADDLE ROTATION RULES ARE IN EFFECT DURING THIS TIME.
- PLAYERS ARE ASKED TO CHOOSE THE COURT BASED ON YOUR LEVEL. LEVELS ARE LISTED ABOVE PADDLE HOLDERS.
- IF YOU FIND AN EMPTY COURT FOR YOUR LEVEL YOU MAY BEGIN A GAME IF YOU HAVE ENOUGH PLAYERS.
- OR YOU MAY PLACE YOUR PADDLE IN THE PADDLE RACK OF ANY COURT AT YOUR LEVEL IF YOU WISH TO ROTATE ONTO THE COURT FOR THE NEXT GAME.
- REFER TO PADDLE ROTATION RULES TO DETERMINE THE NUMBER OF PLAYERS THAT WILL ROTATE IN.
- IF YOU HAVE 4 PLAYERS AND THERE IS AN EMPTY COURT AT YOUR LEVEL, USE THE EMPTY COURT. THE 4 PADDLE UP RULE IS ONLY FOR TIMES WHEN ALL COURTS ARE FULL.
- PADDLES MUST BE IN THE HOLDER BEFORE THE CURRENT GAME ENDS.

REC. PLAY AFTER 11AM EVERYDAY (UNLESS A CLUB ACTIVITY IS SCHEDULED)

- RECREATIONAL PLAY IS A TIME TO ALLOW A FOURSOME OF RESIDENTS & THEIR GUESTS TO PLAY AMONGST THEMSELVES WITHOUT HAVING TO LET OTHER OTHERS PLAYERS ROTATE IN.
- ANY COURT CAN BE USED REGARDLESS OF SKILL LEVEL. DURING THIS TIME IT IS CONSIDERED FIRST COME FIRST SERVE.
- PADDLE ROTATION RULES DO NOT APPLY DURING THIS TIME.

CLUB PLAY VARIOUS DAYS & TIMES CLUB PLAY TAKES PRECEDENCE OVER ALL OTHER COURT USAGE

- CLUB PLAY IS THE USAGE OF ONE OR ALL THE COURTS FOR CLUB ACTIVITIES THAT ARE SPONSORED BY THE PICKLEBALL CLUB.
- YOU MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE A COURT IF IT IS NEEDED FOR A CLUB ACTIVITY.
- YOU MUST JOIN THE CLUB TO PARTICIPATE IN CLUB ACTIVITIES.
- IN MANY CASES YOU MUST SIGN UP AHEAD OF TIME TO PARTICIPATE IN MANY OF THE CLUB ACTIVITIES.

COURT RULES

- > ALL RESIDENTS, GUESTS AND CLUB MEMBERS MUST FOLLOW COURT PLAY AND ROTATION RULES LISTED BELOW.
- > RESIDENTS DO NOT NEED TO BE A CLUB MEMBER TO PLAY ON THE COURTS.
- > NO PETS OR SMOKING ON COURTS, BREEZEWAY OR PATIO AT BUILDING D.
- > NO FOOD ALLOWED ON THE COURTS.
- > NO ROLLER SKATES, SKATEBOARDS, BICYCLES OR REMOTE CONTROL CARS ARE ALLOWED ON COURTS, BREEZEWAY OR PATIO AT BUILDING D.

CLUB MEMBERS

- > RESIDENTS MUST BE A PICKLEBALL CLUB MEMBER TO PARTICIPATE IN CLUB EVENTS. MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION LOCATED IN BOX BELOW.
- > CLUB ACTIVITIES TAKE PRECEDENCE OVER ALL OTHER COURT USAGE.

GUEST POLICY AND RESIDENT ID'S

- > ONLY RESIDENTS AND THEIR GUESTS MAY USE THE COURTS.
- > ALL RESIDENTS SHOULD HAVE THEIR RESIDENT ID CARD OR A PHOTO OF IT IN THEIR POSSESSION WHILE USING THE COURTS.
- > GUESTS USING THE COURTS WITHOUT A RESIDENT PRESENT MUST POSSESS A VALID GUEST CARD.
- > VISITORS WITHOUT A GUEST PASS MUST USE THE COURTS WITH A RESIDENT PRESENT.
- > CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 16 MAY USE THE COURTS ONLY WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY A GUEST WITH A VALID PASS OR RESIDENT OF SCPD.
- > GUEST PASSES ARE SOLD TO LEGAL RESIDENT AT FRONT DESK AT THE MOUNTAIN VIEW CLUBHOUSE.
