



**SCPD - PICKLEBALL CLUB
BOARD MEETING MINUTES
February 2, 2026**

- I. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 3:00 pm by Mr. Allison.
- II. **Meeting Location:** Lakeview Club House, Silverwood Room.
- III. **Attendance:** Rich Allison, Bob Briedis, Sandy Berk, Rick Dowdle, Taffy Golden, Jean Mylen, Devon Foster Heckert, Ron Golden, Tom Watson
- IV. **The Minutes** of January 5, 2026, were reviewed. And, Addendum to the minutes was added to clarify a potential budget variance of \$600.00 for the Pickleball Dinner/Dance. Ms. Berk indicated that she needed additional funds for the purchase of reusable decorations. The Addendum required addition clarification by the board, which was provided by Mr. Dowdle. The Minutes of January 5 and the Addendum of January 16, moved forward for Board approval. There was a motion by Ms. Berk to approve the Minutes and Addendum as written and a second by Ms. Mylen. There was a unanimous vote by the Board to approve both the Minutes and Addendum as written.
- V. **The Treasurer's Report** was presented by Mr. Briedis. Mr. Briedis reported a checking account balance of \$22,377. as of January 30, 2026. He pointed out that this balance does not include the expenses incurred of \$2,100 for the dinner/dance. There was a motion to approve the Treasurer's report as written by Mr. Dowdle, and a second by Ms. Berk, and a unanimous vote was carried to approve the Treasurer's report written.
- VI. **Membership** was reported. There are 532 paid members as of January 30, 2026. New membership accounts for ninety-three (93) new members since the last reporting period.
- VII. **SCPD Pickleball Website** – Mr. Golden presented the SCPD Website. The site is now active through the SCPD website link. He indicated that there are some functional limitations within the site, but there are work arounds. He encouraged everyone to view the site and provide feedback to him.
- VIII. **Merchandise Sales** – Mr. Watson presented the possibility selling pickleball clothing through the club or the pro-shop. The pro-shop is not interested in selling pickleball clothing as the Club could not predict the volume of sales. The club would not be able to carry out sales of merchandise for tax reasons, sales limitations, and the inability to maintain inventory. This topic of discussion is now dropped with no further discussion needed unless there is a significant change brought forth to the Board.
- IX. **Demo Day** - Mr. Watson reported that Demo Day was a success. It was estimated that there were 200-300 people in attendance. There were four (4) paddle vendors present at the event. Mr. Watson reported that he did not know how many pickleball paddles were purchased because of the event. He guesstimated maybe 25 paddles.

- X. Elections:** Pickleball Club will have the following voting board positions open for 2026 – 2027: a.) VP – Events, and b.) Treasurer. The positions are for a two (2) year term of 2026 through 2028. Mr. Allison asked Steve and Robin Daw to solicit members. They had no success in finding volunteers. All Board members were encouraged to talk up the positions to fill the positions. Several club members’ names were offered at this meeting as possible board candidates. It was noted that SCPD HOA requires club board positions in order to fully operate under chartered club rules.

- B. Ms. Mylen suggested that the News & Views (pickleball section) provides information on significant Club events only. It was noted by Ms. Berk that there are number flyers emailed to members weekly as an additional communication tool.
- C. Mr. Allison discussed the documentary produced by Errol Magidson (“Del Webb – Renaissance Man”). Mr. Magidson suggested that the pickleball club promote his presentation and discussion. The group discussed this matter and decided not to promote his presentation as was advertised in the News & Views. The Club is not set up to advertise or promote groups or individual endeavors.
- D. Mr. Allison informed the group that Jeff Cohen resigned as a member at large.
